

NZWSRA Job Descriptions

Below are brief descriptions of jobs that need doing for ski racing to run. Please read them and think about what you could do to help out. If we all do a job then nothing is too hard!!! Contact David or Tracey if you're interested or want more information.

Executive positions – This committee makes most of the decisions and is responsible for running events

President – This mainly involves checking that everyone and everything are running smoothly. Running events, liaising with race organisers and generally keeping everything running smoothly

Vice President – The president's right hand man. Helping out as much as possible and taking responsibility if the president can't be there

Secretary – Keeping minutes and records and doing lake closures are the main responsibilities, as well as helping to run events

Treasurer – Like the treasurer for any club this person looks after all expenses in and out. You don't necessarily have to have experience to do this job

Exec members – Generally help with running races and organising both before and on race day

Junior exec member – This position involves the same as an exec member, but is for one of our under 19 skiers to provide a younger viewpoint

Other jobs....

Technical rules committee – This committee decides and reviews all decisions to do with rules. This job is mostly before race day

Scrutineers – This involves a few people each weekend checking boats to ensure they are compliant, involves a few hours at the start of each meeting

Judges – We are always short of these. This job can be taught to anybody and is especially good for those supporters with free time on their hands!

Bridge to Bridge organiser – This is our major event and needs a team of people to put it together.

Ski School – This school is held for a week in January and involves organising the students, venue and needs for 50 people for a week

Membership – Someone needs to collate members each year and maintain this contact list

Rescue Boat – This needs to be maintained, stored and taken to venues

Bus – This also needs to be maintained, stored and taken to venues

NZ Water Ski Association – Two people need to sit on the committee for our parent organisation. Meetings are about every 6 weeks.

Selectors – Five people to watch how racing is going and make team selections, usually just for the Trans Tasman team

National Coach – This person develops and coaches not only our representative teams, but anyone needing help and assistance with their skiing

100 Miler Organiser – One or two people to put this race together and try to get some sponsorship

Event Organisers – All events need someone in charge of them, preferably a local, to organise food, course boats, sponsorship and anything else needed

Social Coordinator – This person lets people know about social events around races, organizes get togethers.
