## Things you should know about the day...

- Brooklyn Ski Club is situated 1100m past the Karapiro Domain
- Brooklyn members have hot food available to purchase from 8am for Breakfast and Lunch
- Please stick around and have dinner as the BWSC is putting this on for us also. Dinner Tickets cost \$20 per head which include 2 free Beers/Wines or 4 Non Alcoholic Drinks
- So don't bring any beers or food – support the BWSC and buy meals and drinks from them
- Respect the club grounds and try not to rip them up too much with your vehicles.
- Only vehicles with trailers down the bottom of the club. All cars without trailers need to be to the left of the clubrooms or up top. We will be very limited for room.

## Things you should know about the racing...

- **Enter in everything** – races are short and are way more fun when everyone gets out there.
  - Powerboat Races are raced under **NZWSRA Rules** which means NZWSRA distances between boats at all times
  - **Keep boats in the water** as much as possible to avoid too much congestion
  - **Listen** to the ramp co-ordinator
  - **Pre Enter** if possible
  - \$10 per race or \$60 to do as many as you like
  - Races 6, 8 & 11 are FREE to enter
- 
- **Ladies** grab your 1 (and only) chance of the season to get in the drivers seat of the boat and give it a pedal – The famous Ladies Powerboat race is back for 2010
  - **Drag Races** – seeded from the powerboat races – boats will be paired up and race off with the winner staying in and loser back to the beach until we have 1 boat left.
  - Also back is the **Anything but a Ski Race** – so crank out your plank, kneeboard, tube or park bench and have some fun. Not just for kids.
