### **TR1 LICENCE ISSUE PROCEDURE**

1. Written test supervised by regional licence tester. Multi test paper TR2 to be completed under supervision without assistance. No rule book permitted. Maximum time allowed 30 minutes with 28 out of 31 questions to be answered correctly.
2. If passed send Test paper to the Executive Chief Judge for sign off before forwarding to the Licence co-ordinators, requesting that the Novice Licence to be issued. When membership details are confirmed issue Novice Licence along with Nominated buddy competitors Name and Boat No.  
Send Test Papers to Tech Rules for review and filing.
3. Notify race organiser of all Novice Licence issues.
4. After 5 Sanctioned series event races an Open Licence can be issued as per Rule 61.09
5. Regional Testers Ian Witheford, Rick Powell, Richard Mayne, Dave Hanks, Chris Carter, Emma Duckworth

### **Day Licence Driver – Observer – Skier**

1. TR3 Day Licence Application Form to be completed.
2. Applicant to be nominated by current member and licence holder.
3. Applicants to be briefed as per TR3.
4. All Day Licences issued to be recorded and notified to the Chief Judge and Executive Chief Judge before days racing begins.
5. All day licences are to be filed by Tech Rules with only TWO one day licences being issued per competition season per person.
6. Day Licence issues to be done by Regional Licence Testers.
